#### **Directions to PSU Berks**

- **1**. *From points east:* Follow Route 422 West to Reading. Continue onto Route 222 North and follow to the Broadcasting Rd exit. Turn right at the stop light and the PSU campus will be on the right.
- **2.** *From points west:* Follow Rt. 422 East and pick up Route 222 North. Take the Broadcasting Rd exit. Turn right at the stop light and the PSU campus will be on the right.
- **3.** <u>From points north:</u> Take Route 222 South toward Reading. Exit on the Broadcasting Rd exit and make a left hand turn onto Broadcasting Rd. Follow under the 222 overpass and PSU campus will be on the right.
