Facilities include ample parking, tours of the Isaac Meier House and the Country Fare event, hosted by the Isaac Meier Homestead.

Isaac Meier was born on 4 January 1730, near the Conestoga Creek in Lancaster County, the son of Palatine migrants who had arrived in the area a few years earlier.

In 1754, he married Catherine Herckelrod, whose father owned 249 acres of land further north in Berks County. On the death of Catherine's father in February 1757, the land was sold to Isaac, who moved with his family to live at the property.

Over the course of the next few years, Isaac acquired several other tracts of land, and became quite wealthy, operating as a banker and money lender, and was also a magistrate for the district. In the 1760's he began to subdivide various portions of land and deeding out lots for a town which he planned to call Tulpehocken Town (Turtle Town), after the creek which runs through the area.

On the night of 14 July 1770, Meier was invited to attend a local tavern known as the Henry Buch Haus, and it is presumed that this was a business appointment. While he was seated in the tavern, near a front window, he was shot in the neck by an unknown assailant and died the following day. Isaac had been friendly with John Penn, the Governor of Pennsylvania, who offered a 100-pound reward for the apprehension of his murderers, but they were never found.
